

The Vale of Evesham Historical Society General Information Protection Regulation 2018

Members' Rights

Under the regulations, members have specific rights¹:

You have the right to know about the information being held

- what personal information the society holds
- who holds the information
- · how long the information is held

You have the right to know specifically what information we have about you.

You have the right of "data portability": to obtain the information we hold in a form that you can reuse for your own purposes.

You have the right to request, where the information we have is inaccurate or incomplete, that this is rectified.

You have the right to have personal information erased at any time: this includes any information beyond the minimum we need to keep in touch².

You have the "right to be forgotten" when you cease to be a member: to have all information about you erased even before we would do so normally³.

You have the right to have other information

- what we are doing with the information
- on what legal basis we are using or "processing" the information.

You have the absolute right to prevent our use of the information for marketing purposes⁴ and a (limited) right to restrict our use for other specific purposes, including any analysis for scientific or historical research and statistics.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office, if you are unhappy about how we keep or use your information, or how we respond to any complaint.
